

Travel Tray

Supply list:

Outside fabric: 9-1/2" x 9-1/2"

Thin batting: 9-1/2" x 9-1/2"

Inside fabric: 9-1/2" x 9-1/2" - should be a lighter color so you can see the "stuff" in the tray

Velco strips: will be provided by the guild

Sewing machine, supplies, thread, scissors, etc.

Either a free motion foot or a walking foot for quilting the inner tray area

Ruler, fabric marker that will disappear

Directions:

1. Fabric right sides together, batting on the bottom of the stack
2. Sew around, leave 3-4" to turn; turn and press, tucking in opening ends; topstitch around which will close the opening.
3. Measure 1.5" in from all sides and mark with disappearing ink or like, stitch over lines
4. Quilt inner area, either with straight lines or random (your choice)
5. Velco strips applied; put over the marked line, sew down the middle 1/2 on one side, and 1/2 on the other side
